Wednesday, May 7 **National Bike to School Day**Bike to school in Monterey County

National Bike to School Day provides an opportunity for schools across America to join together to celebrate and build off the energy of Bike Month. Although May 7 is announced as Bike to School Day, schools in Monterey County can take advantage of the resources provided by the National Center for Safe Routes to School to schedule Bike to School events throughout Bike Month or anytime during the year. Saturday, May 10
3rd Annual Bicycling Monterey Intergenerational Bike Ride
Fort Ord Dunes State Park (starting point)

This is a free, family-friendly event for visitors and locals of all ages, organized annually by Fine Wordworking. For details, click here.

All non-motorized bicycles are welcome, including beach cruisers, BMX, cargo, commuter, fixed gear, lowrider, mountain, recumbent, road, tandem, trail-a-bike, vintage, and other people-powered bicycles. Riders will gather at Fort Ord Dunes State Park parking lot, where representatives from Monterey County's diverse bike community will be introduced briefly before the ride gets rolling. The ride departure point is in a section of Monterey County's Class I (no motor vehicles) bike/multi-use trail system that is less heavily traveled, yet still includes beautiful coastal views. The trail here features three paved lanes: a striped two-lane path for bicyclists, and an adjacent lane for pedestrians. A complimentary mobile mechanic for minor, on-the-spot maintenance will ride with the group to and from Custom House Plaza. All ages and abilities are welcome to participate for even part of the ride.

On Thursdays, males and females get 10-50-% discounts off their total tab (alcohol may be excluded) at more than 200 places in 18 Monterey County cities. HER is an acronym for the types of businesses and organizations participating in The HER Helmet Thursdays Project— Hotels, Educational/entertainment venues, Restaurants, and related places. HER also refers to Mother Earth, who benefits from more people biking! Why the helmet? For all except Lodging discounts, bike or bike-and-ride to the location, then show your helmet as evidence. For lodging, BYOB (bring your own bike) or rent a bike for a day or more from any Monterey County rental location. The HER Helmet Thursdays Project was established in 2009 by Mari Lynch of Bicycling Monterey.
