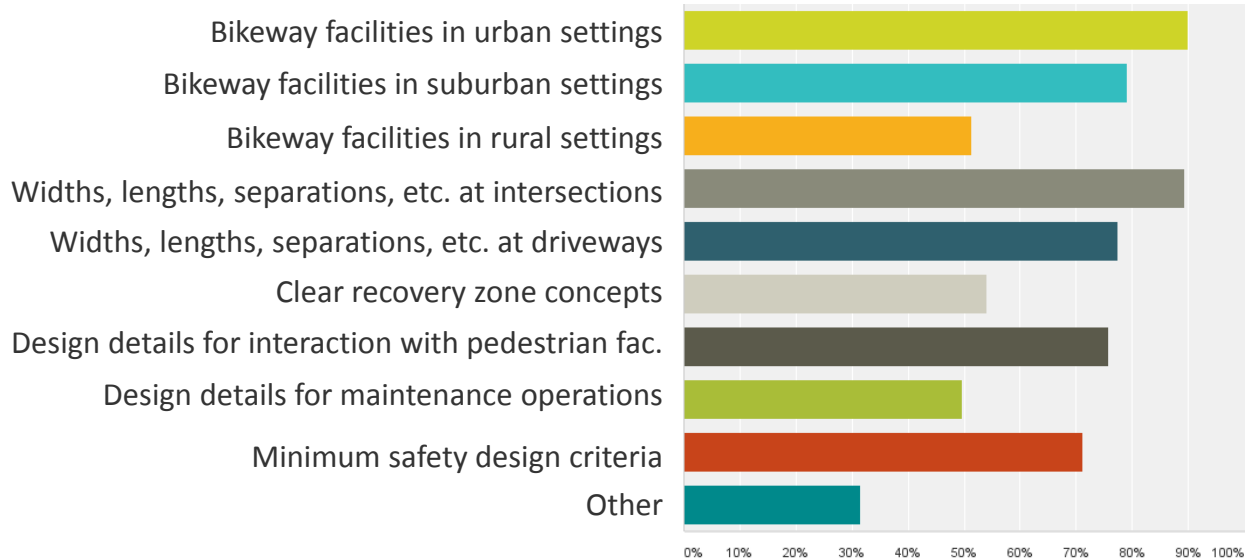

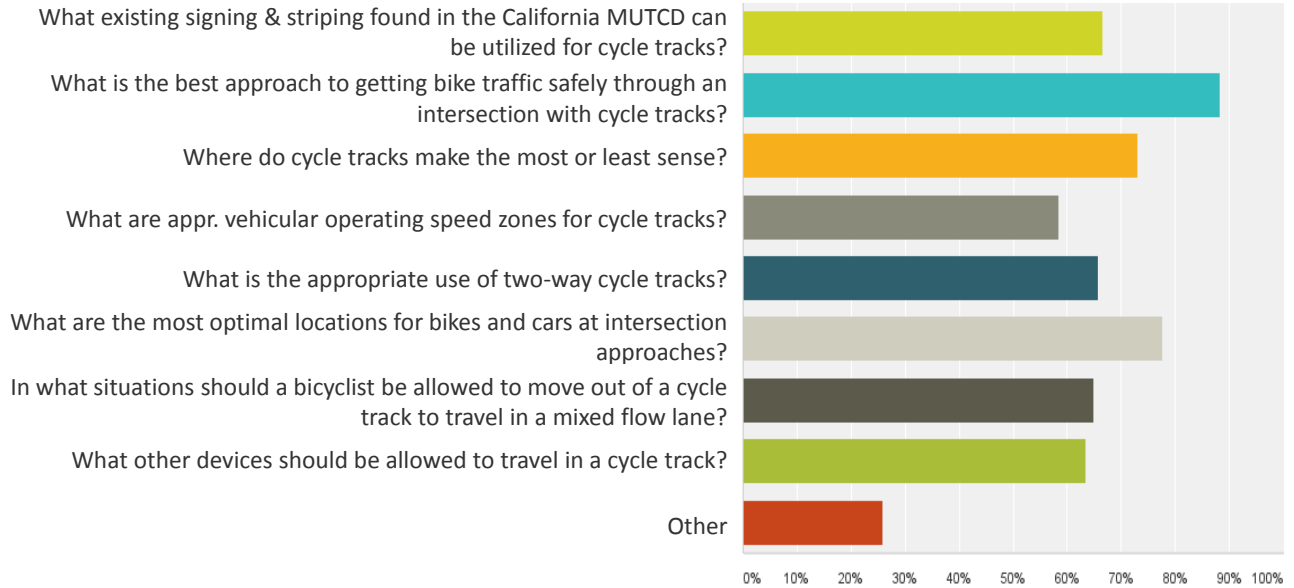
## Design - Which of the following specific items should the ideal Class IV Bikeway Guidance cover in terms of design?
